Facts about Nebraskans with Disabilities:

- ♥ About 12% of all Nebraskans have a disability
- ♥ Half of Nebraskans with a disability have part-time or full-time jobs IN THE COMMUNITY and many more want to work or work more hours

- ♥ 86% of Nebraskans with a disability live IN THE COMMUNITY - with their families (70%) or alone or with a roommate (16%)
- ♥ Almost one-quarter (24%) of Nebraskans with a disability live at or below the Poverty level (compared with just 9% of all Nebraskans)
- ♥ People with disabilities who live IN THE COMMUNITY (as opposed to institutions) report that they are happier with where they live, who they live with, and how they live their lives.
- ♥ Nebraskans with disabilities provide thousands of volunteer hours every year IN THEIR COMMUNITIES, schools, churches, service organizations, and healthcare facilities.
